Chris Alan Morrow, son of William C. Morrow and Carolyn Yvonne Taylor, was born September 3, 1960 in Athens, Tennessee where he grew up and graduated from high school.

On October 5, 1979, Chris was united in marriage to Tammy Leveta Wilson in Waynesville, Missouri. They just celebrated 41 years of marriage together and were blessed with three children: Tonya, Leveta and Nathan.

Shortly after graduating from high school, Chris entered the United States Army. After he and Tammy were married, they were stationed in Ft. Stewart, Georgia for one year. They then moved back to Waynesville where they have remained.

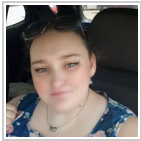

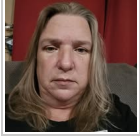
