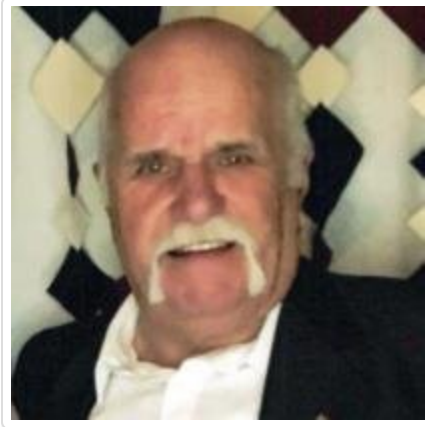




Earnest Wayne Box
