



Edward Lee "Ed" Sheldon

October 11, 1937 - March 17, 2015

Edward Lee "Ed" Sheldon, son of the late Lewis Heltzel and Nellie Mae (George) Sheldon, was born October 11, 1937 in Hooker, Missouri. Ed grew up in Devils Elbow and moved to Dixon and graduated with the Class of 1956 from Dixon High School.

Shortly after graduation, Ed began working in the building trade business. He then became a Pulaski County Deputy and served for sixteen years. He started as a road officer and finished his career as a bailiff.

In his spare time, Ed enjoyed being outdoors while working in his garden and taking care of the little bit of livestock that he had. He also liked to watch television and visit with his friends and family. He was a member of the Masonic Lodge #346 for 50 years and was a member of the First Baptist Church of Waynesville.

Ed passed away Tuesday, March 17, 2015 in the Mercy Hospital of St. Louis, Missouri having attained the age of 77 years.

Ed leaves to cherish his memory two sons: Craig Sheldon of Ft. Calhoun, NE and Jason Sheldon of Waynesville, MO; one brother: Gary Sheldon of St. Robert, MO; four granddaughters: Molly, Rachel, Rebecca and Mattie; several nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.

In addition to his parents, Ed was preceded in death by eight siblings: Fern Foster, Vivian DeTrofford, June Griffith, Carolyn Switzer, Charles, Don, Paul and Jim Shelden; and one son: Brian Shelden.

Memorial services were held at 11:00 a.m. Saturday, March 21, 2015 in the Memorial Chapels and Crematory of Waynesville / St. Robert with Pastor Lindell Shelden officiating. Ed's friend, Bob Belton, recalled his wonderful memories of Ed. Soloist Becky Lercher sang "Amazing Grace" and "I'll Fly Away".

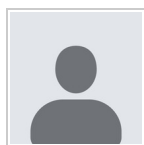

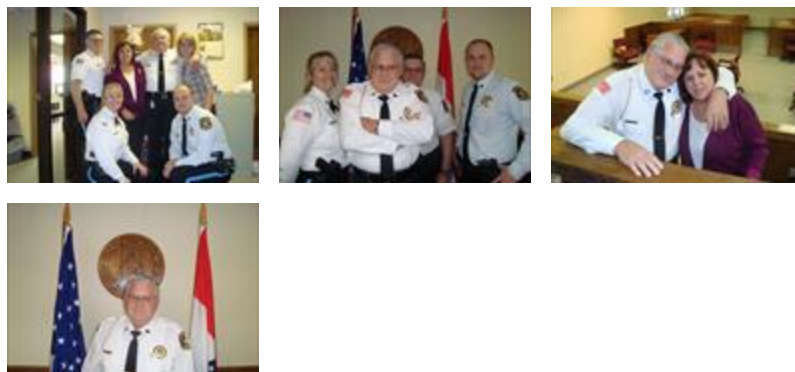
