Elfriede Marianne (Noller) Linane, daughter of the late Johann George and Magdalene Marie (Ikinger) Noller, was born February 5, 1930 in Frankenberg, Germany where she grew up and attended school.

On April 20, 1955, Elfriede was united in marriage to John J. Linane in Germany. They shared over 35 years of marriage together and many wonderful memories. John preceded her in death on June 28, 1990.

Elfriede and John came to the United States in 1956 and were immediately sent to Fort Leonard Wood where John was stationed. After John's discharge from the military, they decided to stay in the St. Robert / Fort Leonard Wood area where Elfriede has remained since that time.

Elfriede was a hardworking woman and worked for many years for Rice's Cleaners. 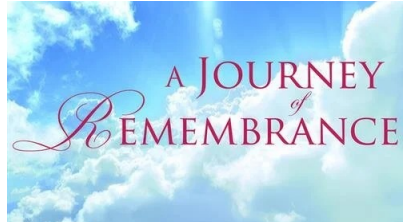
