Ermalee Calvo departed this life January 29, 2011, at the Shawnee Mission Medical Center, Shawnee, Kansas, at the age of 81 years, 5 months and 19 days.

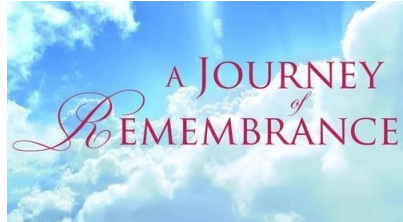
Burial will be held at a later date in Lowry City, Missouri. Services were under the direction of Memorial Chapels and Crematory of Waynesville / St. Robert.

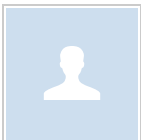
