James Dean January, son of Myron Ray January and Mary Armeda (Micheletti) January Kidd, was born February 21, 1957 in Aberdeen, Washington.

As a young boy, the family moved to the Waynesville, Missouri area where he attended and graduated from high school.

James entered the United States Army and served his country faithfully for 6 ½ years until his honorable discharge. He had attained the rank of Sergeant and earned several awards and commendations.
