Javier Gamboa Guerrero, 66, of Waynesville, MO, passed away on 14 September 2021. He was born to Angelina and Juan, on 29 August 1955 in Santa Maria, CA. He grew up in Santa Maria and then went on to graduate from Santa Maria High in 1973.

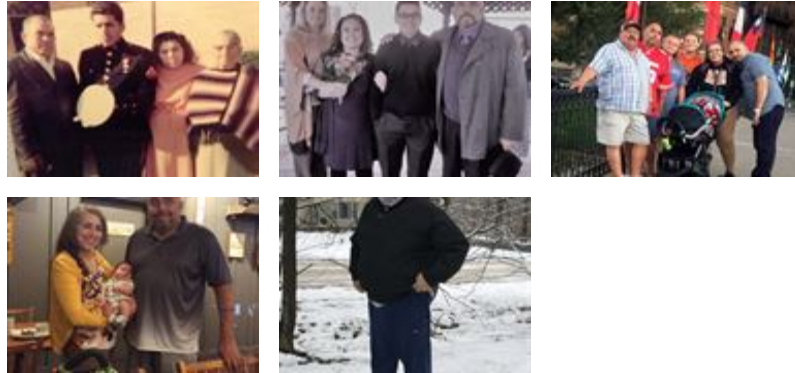
