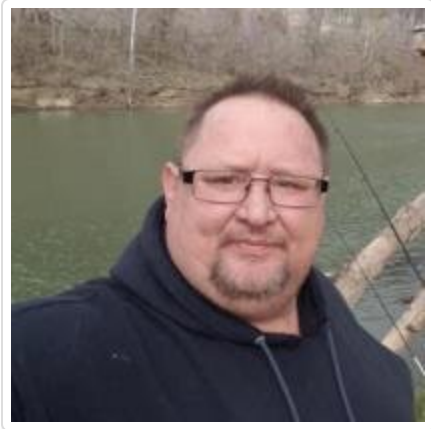




Jeffery DeWayne Lofton
