Marion Lee Jr. Exendine, son of Marion and Elva (Myers) Exendine, was born on November 13, 1935, in Bloodland, Missouri. He departed this life April 5, 2021 in Mercy Hospital in Lebanon, Missouri at the age of 85 years, 4 months, and 23 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents, a brother, Clyde Exendine, and three sisters, Ailene Kinworthy, his twin sister, Melva (Lois) Hatcher, and Lilly Cyr.
