She retired from over-the-road truck driving at the age of 65.

Her greatest joy throughout her life was being a mother and grandmother. Her children Michelle, Chris and Carrie learned unconditional love and tireless devotion to children through her example. Although she longed for a granddaughter, she adored her grandsons AJ, Cale, Dereck, Lane and Seth. She played ball with them, attended their important events, read to them, and when needed corrected them.

She loved to paint and craft. Her love of cooking and feeding a crowd brought people together.

She was an active member of First Baptist Church of Swedeborg.

Services were under the direction of Memorial Chapel of Richland.

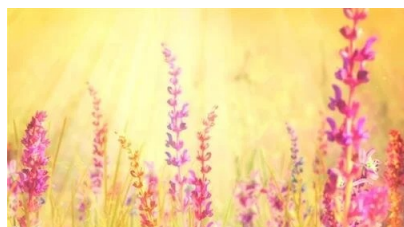

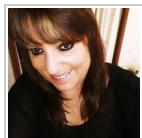

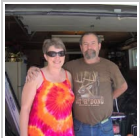
