There are no services planned at this time and arrangements are under the care and direction of Memorial Chapels and Crematory of Waynesville / St.

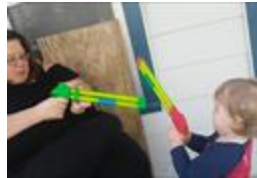
