



Larry Lee Moore Sr.

March 2, 1950 - April 18, 2014

Larry Lee Moore, Sr., son of the late Marcus and Lizzie (West) Moore, was born March 2, 1950 in Cincinnati, Ohio. As a young boy, Larry grew up in Grandview, Indiana and graduated from high school in Rockport, Indiana. He later furthered his education and obtained his Associate's Degree from Central Texas College at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri.

At the age of 19, Larry entered the United States Army and became a heavy equipment/combat engineer. He served his country faithfully until his honorary discharge in 1982. He attained the rank of Sergeant and earned several awards and commendations; some of which include: National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal with 2 Bronze Service Stars, Vietnam Campaign Medal, Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, Republic of Vietnam Cross of Gallantry, Good Conduct Medal (3rd Award), Armed Services Ribbon, Overseas Service Ribbon, and the Expert Qualification Badge (M-16).

On April 6, 1970, Larry was united in marriage to Shelia Ann Clark in Waynesville, Missouri. They shared over 44 years of marriage together and were blessed with two children: Lee Ann and Larry, Jr.

After leaving the military, Larry continued serving his country through working for Civil Service as a heavy equipment mechanic for 10 years and medical Warehouseman for 10 years before he had to medically retire in 2002.

In his spare time, Larry enjoyed being outdoors while fishing, hunting, camping and playing softball. He also loved to tinker with old cars and motorcycles. Most importantly, he treasured spending time with his family and friends. He never met a stranger and enjoyed visiting with people. He was a member of the Disabled American Veterans and American Legion.

Larry passed away Friday, April 18, 2014 in his home in Dixon, Missouri having attained the age of 64 years. He will be sadly missed but fondly remembered by all those that knew and loved him.

Larry leaves to cherish his memory, his wife: Shelia Moore of the home; daughter: Lee Ann Moore of Waynesville, MO; son: Larry Moore, Jr. (Audrey) of Waynesville, MO; seven grandchildren: Jordan Moore, Kennedi Moore, Savanna Lorentzson, Wyatt Cook, Keagan Dowling, Madison Lowe, and Ellijah Heagerty all of Waynesville, MO; brother: Roy; sister: Virginia; dozens of nieces and nephews; other relatives and friends.

In addition to his parents, Larry was preceded in death by four brothers: John, Martin, Jimmy and Gary; and two sisters: Patricia and Brenda.

Funeral services were held at 10:00 a.m. Thursday, April 24, 2014 in the Memorial Chapels and Crematory of Waynesville / St. Robert with Rev. Danny Graves officiating. The songs "Angels Among Us", "Good Morning Beautiful" and "American Soldier" were played. Serving as escorts were Larry Lee Moore, Jr., Lee Ann Moore, Kerry Moore, Randy Wheatley, Tom Clark and Scott Clark.

Burial with military honors followed in the Missouri Veterans Cemetery – Fort Leonard Wood. Military honors were provided by the Missouri Honors Team. Services were under the direction of Memorial Chapels and Crematory of
