Arrangements are under the direction of Memorial Chapels and Crematory of Waynesville / St. Robert.

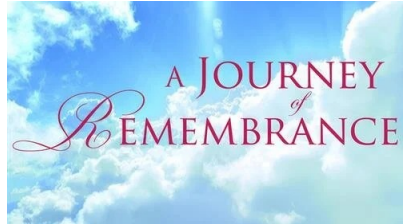

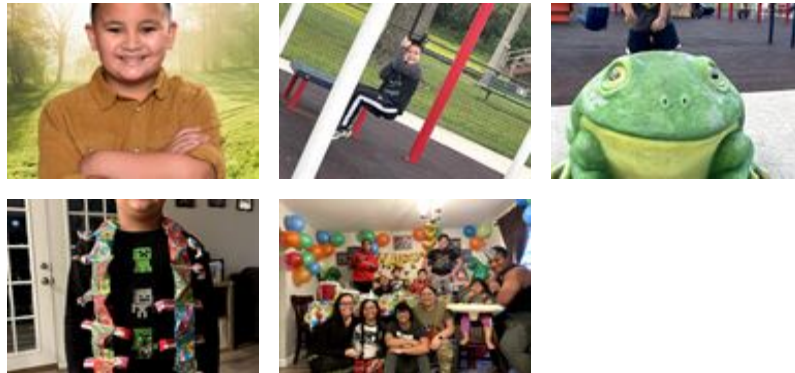

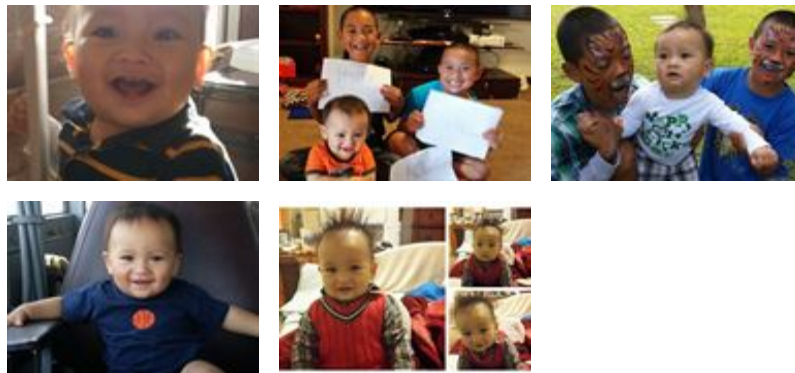
