



Norma Evelyn Deardeuff

January 4, 1920 - April 28, 2013

Norma Evelyn Deardeuff, daughter of the late John W. and Helen Mary (Whalen) Hamilton, was born January 4, 1920 near Crocker, Missouri where she grew up and attended school.

On January 1, 1949, Evelyn was united in marriage to the love of her life, Jesse Wayne Deardeuff in Camp Carson, Colorado. They shared over 64 years of marriage together and were blessed with one son, Dwight.

Shortly after their marriage, Evelyn and Jesse moved to the St. Robert, Missouri area. Only for a few times of being stationed overseas, Evelyn and the family have lived here and raised their family.

Evelyn was a hardworking woman. She worked for many years on Fort Leonard Wood as a cafeteria worker. She also worked for Montgomery Wards in the Credit Union in Jefferson City for a time, but her main focus was taking care of her home and family. She was a devoted wife, mother and grandmother and loved spending time with her family, especially the grandchildren.

Evelyn passed away at 8:45 a.m. Sunday, April 28, 2013 in the Sunset Village

of the Ozarks of St. Robert, Missouri having attained the age of 93 years, 3 months and 24 days. She will be sadly missed by all those that knew and loved her.

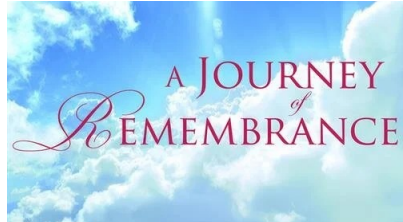
