Pansy P. (McGowan) Dye was born March 4, 1927 to Gus and Almeda (Robertson) McGowan in Swedeborg, Missouri.

At an early age, Pansy accepted Christ as her Savior and was a member of Deerlick Baptist Church.

Pansy was first of all a wife, mother and grandmother. She served as a pastor's wife for over 42 years. She worked various jobs and retired from Walmart in 1989 after working there 25 years.

Pansy enjoyed being outdoors. There was nothing she liked better than walking through the woods and exploring nature. She loved working in her garden and yard. Her hobbies, included crocheting, gardening and sewing. She truly loved spending time with her children and grandchildren.

Pansy passed the morning of Thursday, April 19, 2018 at Life Care Center of Waynesville having attained the age of 91 years, 1 month, and 15 days. She will be sadly missed by all who knew and loved her.

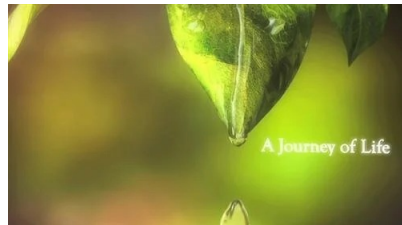
