Melvin “Randall” Sherrer was born in Sleeper, Missouri on March 10, 1947 to Milford “Dean” and Alveda (Burgess) Sherrer, and passed away Sunday, January 24, 2021, while in Lake Regional Hospital, Osage Beach, Missouri, having attained the age of 73.

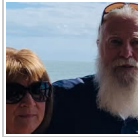
