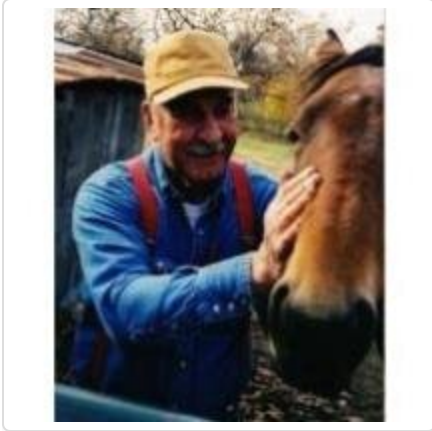




Robert A. Dillon

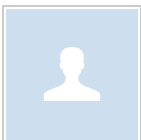

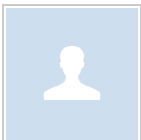
