Ruby Jewell Clark, daughter of the late James Luther and Mary Suzanna (Poe) Massey, was born December 18, 1942 in Licking, Missouri. She passed away Saturday, September 29, 2012 in the Mercy Hospital of Springfield, Missouri having attained the age of 69 years, 9 months and 11 days.

Memorial contributions may be made in memory of Ruby Clark to the American Cancer Society and may be left at the funeral home.

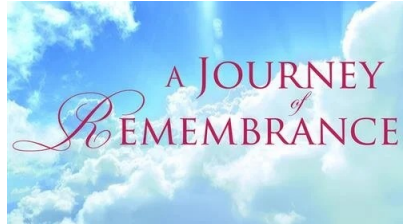
