Sherri Ann (Mink) McGee, daughter of Stanley and Patricia (Pike) Mink, was born June 16, 1971 at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri. She passed away Wednesday, September 26, 2012 in the Dixon Nursing and Rehab Center of Dixon, Missouri. She had attained the age of 41 years, 3 months and 9 days.

Sherri grew up in the Waynesville area and graduated from Waynesville High School in 1989. She later attended Drury University and Metro Business College.

Sherri was united in marriage to John McGee and they were blessed with one daughter, Zoe. John preceded Sherri in death on August 25, 1993.

Sherri worked for a time in the photo lab at Wal-Mart and later began working with CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates). She was the coordinator for the program and she loved helping people, especially children.
