Thomas Creg Bohrer (Creg) passed away in Steamboat Springs, Colorado at 9:55 am on November 23, 2023 at the age of 54, surrounded by family and friends, after a hard-fought battle with cancer.

Creg was raised in Waynesville, Missouri by his loving parents Thomas and Mary Bohrer. A wild spirit, Creg spent most of his time outdoors with friends or with his family on the farm training and showing horses and mules. It was at the family car dealership, M&S Motors, where Creg discovered his love and talent for working with cars. On December 5, 1991, Creg's twin daughters, Ashley and Brittany were born.
