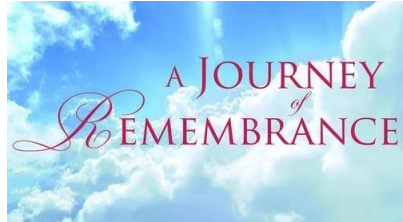
Services were under the direction of Memorial Chapel of Richland.

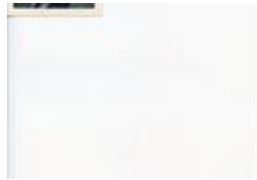

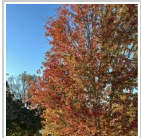
