Victor James Eldredge, son of the late Emerson Alonzo Eldredge and Eva May (Williams) Clark, was born June 11, 1919 in Waynesville, Missouri. He left this world on August 10, 2012 to be with his Lord and Savior after his long battle with cancer. He entered the gates of heaven on what would have been his 65th wedding anniversary to join the love of his life, Mary Frances.

As a young man he professed his faith in Christ with the Mt. Washington Baptist Church in Independence, Missouri.

Victor proudly served his country in the United States Army during World War II and was a combat veteran of the elite 82nd Airborne 505th Parachute Infantry Regiment. He served with the division from North Africa to Germany, making many combat jumps. He was the recipient of the Purple Heart and Bronze Stars.

In his earlier years, Victor loved hunting, fishing and camping at Lake of the Ozarks. Many summers were spent with his family at "Chigger Point" at the Lake. Nieces, nephews and family fondly remember "Uncle Bump" and "Aunt Frankie" water skiing and having summer fun at the Lake.

Victor lived in Independence, Missouri most of his married life. He worked as a metallurgy inspector at Armco Steel Corporation in Kansas City, Missouri,

retiring in 1980 with 33 years of service.

After retirement, Victor and Mary enjoyed many wonderful years together at Lake of the Ozarks and in their hometown of Richland.

Victor was a 50-year member of the Mt. Washington Masonic Lodge #614 in Independence, MO, the Scottish Rite, and Ararat Shrine in Kansas City, MO.

He was a friend to all and will be sadly missed, and lovingly remembered by his family, friends and all who knew him.
