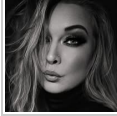

Every box had a different countries bill I suppose to expose us children to diversity in currency form. I collected them all, every box I was first to open! I saved all of them, not knowing any better that the held no dollar amount. And seeing other families use paper food stamps (that's telling my age haha) I thought I could use that money and buy me some candy. So one day while my dad was in the tackle shop I came in to the market grabbed all the candy I could. Put it on the counter and handed her the fake money from China and Russia and she was so sweet, she bent down and quietly told me it would not work and I tried to tell her it was food stamps and she shook her head, smiled and told me no I was mistaken. I was very embarrassed and I've thought about that several times throughout my life. She gave me a piece of gum for the quarter of real money I had and sent me on my way. We never spoke about it and she never told my elders, if she did it didn't get back to me. I always respected her for that. Like it was our secret. Although I have not seen her in many years. It still seems like yesterday. Prayers for you all may God comfort you in your time of grief.

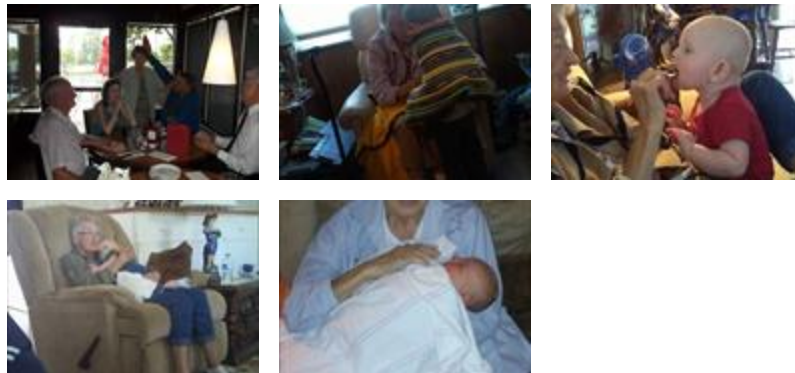
